Certificate Description:

All courses are self-paced and online, with most courses providing FREE contact nursing hours. These courses reflect the core public health competencies set forth by the [Quad Council of Public Health Nursing Organizations](#).

The certificate consists of 7 required CORE online courses (which should take approximately 10.5 hours to complete) and 10 ELECTIVE online courses (from which you may choose an additional 5 hours of coursework).

Requirements:

A nursing credential is required. The program is targeted toward RNs working in public health, and to RNs desiring to learn concepts of public health and the wide range of opportunities available to nurses in this area of practice. LPNs and other RN's may also enroll. There is no residency requirement; students may enroll from any geographic location within the US states or territories.

Males registering for the certificate must provide proof of selective service registration.
